



DVSF 2026 Student Checklist

CONGRATULATIONS! You have qualified for the 2026 Delaware Valley Science Fairs. Please use this checklist to help guide you through the next steps.

Important Tasks

- Are you registered with STEM Wizard?
 - Regional fair that used STEM Wizard - Login to dvsf.stemwizard.com with your same username and password. Most of your project information should have been transferred, but you still need to do the following:
 - Fill out additional milestones specific to DVSF
 - Verify all paperwork in the “Files and Forms” Milestones is completed
 - Contact DVSF through STEM Wizard to resolve any issues
 - Regional fair that DID NOT use STEM Wizard -
 - Register your project at dvsf.stemwizard.com
 - Complete all the “Milestones”
 - Ensure your ISEF paperwork is properly uploaded to the “Files and Forms” Milestone.
 - Ensure your project is in the proper grade level/ category
 - **Team Projects compete in the “Teams Category” Ensure that if you are competing as a team, you register as such.**
- Make sure that you have registered using an email address that allows you to receive messages from outside sources (**MOST SCHOOLS DO NOT ALLOW THIS**). We must be able to communicate with you through STEM Wizard, so use a personal or parent or guardian’s email address so our messages do not get blocked.
- Verify the information that is in STEM Wizard
 - Correct project information
 - Correct category information
 - Correct grade-level information

Project Checklist

- Bring at least 5 paper copies of your abstract (some judges like to keep them for use in their deliberations). There is no printer or copy machine at the fair so you will need to bring these with you when you set up on Tuesday.
- Verify that your project conforms to the ISEF rules for display and safety. (Available on our website www.dvsf.org under Students)
- Bring all project materials to Set Up day (Tuesday). You will not be allowed to enter the exhibit hall until the afternoon on Judging Day.
