DVSF By The Numbers | 2023

1,745 students presented at their local STEM research fairs, competing for an opportunity to present at DVSF

879 students presented 817 projects in 15 categories at the April 2023 Delaware Valley Science Fair, including **540 high school students** from Eastern PA, DE, and Southern NJ

406 volunteer judges participated in the 2023 Delaware Valley Science Fair from regional companies, agencies, academic institutions, and more

DVSF students competed for more than \$30,500 in special awards from 49 partner organizations and over \$15,550 in prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each research category

More than 25 colleges and universities participated in the first ever DVSF College Fair!


A few minutes of professional contact with student researchers may make a lifetime of difference in their career.
